## April Outing - Lynford Arboretum & Lakenheath Fen

### Saturday 21st April 2018

Meeting at the arboretum car park at 0930. A good time of year to visit this delightful woodland reserve – Lynford Arboretum is set squarely in the Brecks amidst Thetford Forest, Britain's largest lowland pine forest. The Arboretum contains an eclectic collection of conifers and provides suitable habitat for a good number of bird species including our targets: Firecrest, Hawfinch and Crossbill. Later in the day we will also visit Lakenheath Fen RSPB Reserve, a premier site with a good mixed variety of habitat and impressive birds.

#### Directions:

From Leicester take the A47 to the A1, take the A1 southbound which becomes the A1(M) up to J14, take the A14 to J38, take the A11 to the junction with the B1106, turn left to Brandon, take the A1065 to Mundford, at the island continue on the A1065 taking the first right to Lynford Hall, the car park is on the left opposite the arboretum.
