Meeting at the Fairburn Ings Visitor Centre car park at 0930, the reserve provides a variety of habitats allowing stunning views of birds such as Willow Tits and Tree Sparrows in the woodland, and Lapwings, Snipe and Redshanks in the wet grassland. Our focus will be on the arrival of the early spring migrants such as Willow Warbler, Whitethroat and Blackcap.

Leave the A1 at junction 42 for the A63, and follow signs for Fairburn village on the A1246. Once in the village turn right at Wagon and Horses public house. At the T-junction turn right, and the reserve is 1.5 miles on the left.
