February Outing - Potteric Carr

Saturday 15th February 2020

Meeting at the Visitor Centre Car Park at 0930, Potteric Carr is Yorkshire Wildlife Trust's flagship nature reserve. Its wide range of habitats from open water and marsh to grassland and woodland, covering an area of about 200 ha (500 acres), give it a rich diversity of wildlife. In addition, Potteric Carr's footpaths through attractive scenery make it an ideal venue. The extensive reedbeds provide excellent habitat for the reserves famous wintering population of up to six Bitterns, our target species for the day.
