June Outing - Dearne Valley Old Moor

Saturday 20th June 2020

Meeting at the reserve car park at 0930 our focus will be on summer migrants. This reserve was designed with the aim of providing a year round accessible wildlife spectacle. This has resulted in a wide range of habitats including reedbeds, lakes, wader scrapes, ponds, hedgerow, meadows and wet grassland. The Dearne is an important site for passage and breeding wading birds and rare reedbed species like Bitterns and Bearded Tits. Important habitats include lowland wet grassland, reedbeds, meadows and fen.

Directions:

Leave the M1 at junction 36 and take the A61 (Barnsley). At the next roundabout, follow the brown RSPB Old Moor signs on the A6195 (Doncaster) for approximately four miles.
