

Thanks for downloading the LROS Recorder to enter your records.

Don't worry about the error message, nothing is wrong and easily put right. It is some sort of conflict with Windows 10.

Download the program again and when you get the error message just tick OK.

The program will now load.

Open your Start menu and find LROS Recorder 1_3_1, then click the down arrow to reveal LROS Recorder DB, right click this, highlight "more" and tick "Run as Administrator"

That's it you are now up and running!

There are just a couple of points to complete the download.

Open the recorder and tick "File" in top left corner and tick "Input User Name" Enter your name (with no commas or full stops). If you have any more initials please add them as well, again with no commas full stops or spaces between initials. See the example name at the bottom of the box. Enter town or district in the location, e.g. Leicester, district or the village you live in. OK this and close the recorder.

Re-open the recorder and your name will be in the box "Saving Data To" including the month.

In the location box type My and press enter. This will bring up My Garden plus grid ref. Necessary for entering birds in your garden.

That really is it...you can start to enter your records.

Again a couple of helpful hints: 1) if you enter records after the end of the month for example entering January records at the beginning of February don't forget to tick the box "Use this Month and Year to Save to".

2) if you enter your records on a daily basis always tick "Save Records for Email" and when you open the recorder again in that month you will get a message saying that there is a file for that month and do you want to load it? You must tick YES or you will lose your records!

When you save your records the program will save these records in a folder in your Documents marked LROS DB Records in there is a file eg Moore B_January_2021 (or whatever month it is) just send that file to me by the 6th of the following month.
