

Leicestershire & Rutland Confidential Record List:

Avocet – nest sites.

Barn Owl – nest sites.

Black-necked Grebe – pair in suitable breeding habitat April to July.

Black Redstart – singing at a potential nest site (April to June) or at nest site

Cetti's Warbler – singing birds at potential nesting sites between March and July.

Corn Bunting – singing birds at potential nesting sites between March and July.

Corncrake – calling birds.

Crossbill – nest sites.

Goshawk – displaying or at nest.

Hobby – nest sites.

Kingfisher – nest sites.

Lesser Spotted Woodpecker – drumming or at nest site.

Little Egret – nest sites.

Little Ringed Plover – any possible nest site i.e gravel and sand pits, reservoirs and building sites.

Long-eared Owl – calling birds or at nest between March 1st to end of June.

Mediterranean Gull – nest sites.

Nightingale – singing birds.

Nightjar – churring or at potential nest site.

Osprey – nest sites.

Peregrine – all known or suspected breeding sites all year around.

Quail – calling birds.

Red Kite – nest sites.

Slavonian Grebe – pair in suitable breeding habitat April to July.

Stone Curlew – pair in suitable breeding habitat April to July.

Turtle Dove – purring birds or at nest sites.

Willow Tit – singing or at nest sites.

Plus any other species on the Schedule 1 list.
