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December Outing – Cossington Meadows & Soar Valley

Saturday 6th December 2025

Meeting at Cossington Meadows Nature Reserve main entrance (roadside lay-by parking) at 0900. Cossington Meadows has, over the last few years, established itself as an important habitat for birds in Leicestershire with an impressive species list including many rarities such as Nightjar, Velvet Scoter, Water Pipit, Bearded Tit and Bittern. The main aim of this outing is to provide help in identifying the more common species of birds and a chance to meet the regulars of the LROS outings. If time permits we will also be visiting Wanlip Meadows in the Soar Valley later in the day.

Exit the A6 bypass at Rothley, at the traffic lights turn right towards Cossington, after crossing the canal and river, park on the roadside lay-by, near the main entrance.
