January Outing – Attenborough Nature Reserve

Saturday 24th January 2026

Meeting at the Attenborough Nature Reserve car park at 0930. This complex of flooded gravel pits and islands covers 145 hectares and provides an ideal habitat for a wide range of plants, birds and other wildlife. The nature reserve is designated as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI). Our focus will be on the wintering wildfowl, however, the main aim of this outing is to provide help in identifying the more common species of birds and a chance to meet the regulars of the LROS outings.

The reserve is situated just off the A6005 between Beeston and Long Eaton. Turn on to Barton Lane off the A6005 at McDonalds following the brown tourist signs. The car park is situated at the bottom of Barton Lane.
