September Outing – Far Ings

Saturday 19th September 2026

Meeting at the reserve car park at 0930. Far Ings is situated on the south bank of the Humber Estuary, a major east-west flyway for migrating birds. The pits and reedbeds at Far Ings and along the Humber bank are a legacy of the tile and cement industry which flourished between 1850 and 1959. Thanks to pioneering management by the Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust, the reserve is now rich in wildlife and one of the UK strongholds for Bittern. Our focus will be on passage autumn migrants.

Directions: Leave the A15 at the A1077 turn-off (last exit before the Humber Bridge). Take the first exit from the roundabout, then the first right (look for the brown tourist signs). At the bottom of the hill, turn right. The entrance to the reserve is on the left.
